# Pricing

We provide first class care with transparent, up-front pricing.

We primarily use a time-based system for invoicing our patients who choose to utilize our direct pay/cash pay options, similar to how many lawyers and accountants bill.

Please use the examples to guide your appointment booking.

- Visits for annual skin cancer screening and hair loss evaluation are dedicated visits with 30 minute minimums. Given the comprehensive nature of these visits, please book a longer appointment if additional issues need to be addressed.
- Patients are seen for the time booked. If your needs are longer than your booked appointment time, we are happy to extend your appointment as time permits, priced at the higher time slot used.
- We round up to the next 10 minute billing increment. Please complete and upload your intake paperwork before the appointment to minimize delays thereby making appointments longer and therefore more expensive than necessary.

### **COSMETIC TREATMENTS**

A cosmetic consult is required before all cosmetic treatments to determine if you are an appropriate candidate for a procedure. PRP injections for hair requires an initial hair loss visit.

Cosmetic Consultation	\$300 for a 30 minute appointment
Required before any first time cosmetic procedure	\$200 of the above fee is credited toward a procedure if performed within 30 days of the consultation
Prescription Skin Care visit (For retinoid or other prescriptions for cosmetic reasons)	\$225 for 20 minute visit; if longer and time available, then refer to medical pricing list above for time-based visits
Neuromodulators (Botox, Dysport, Jeuveau, etc)	1 <sup>st</sup> area (glabella/forehead/Crow's feet): \$450 Each additional area \$250
	Hyperhidrosis (axilla): \$1200 – requires 50% deposit to book; we will not do this procedure for insurance-based patients due to the difficulty of getting this procedure authorized and reimbursed through insurance
Customized chemical peels	Starting at \$250; price will be determined at the consultation and is dependent on the various formulations to be used
Microneedling	\$1200/session (includes attempt to obtain platelet rich plasma for processing and use into the microneedled areas; can also include hyaluronic acid if you're not a good candidate for blood draws)
Platelet Rich Plasma injections (for hair loss)	\$1000/session Package of 3 treatments: \$2700
Removal of benign growths (skin tags, seborrheic keratosis)	See Procedure pricing

<sup>\*</sup>In general, any tissue removed is sent to the lab for pathology analysis/recording, even if the tissue is suspected to be "benign" to confirm benign nature of lesions and mitigate the potential medical-legal risks of discarding lesions that have no associated pathology analysis in the medical record.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Lesions are for medical treatment (warts, molluscum, actinic keratoscs, inflamed lesions)

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>Lesions are for cosmetic treatment (may require initial biopsy to confirm diagnosis: sebaceous hyperplasia, syringoma, xanthelasma, seborrheic keratosis, dermatosis papulosa nigra)

#### GOOD FAITH ESTIMATE

#### You have the right to receive a "Good Faith Estimate" explaining how much your medical care will cost.

Under the law, health care providers need to give patients who don't have insurance or who are not using insurance an estimate of the bill for medical items and services.

- You have the right to receive a Good Faith Estimate for the total expected cost of any non-emergency items or services. This includes related costs like medical tests, prescription drugs, equipment, and hospital fees.
- Make sure your health care provider gives you a Good Faith Estimate in writing at least 1 business day before your medical service or item. You can also ask your health care provider, and any other provider you choose, for a Good Faith Estimate before you schedule an item or service.
- o If you receive a bill that is at least \$400 more than your Good Faith Estimate, you can dispute the bill.
- Make sure to save a copy or picture of your Good Faith Estimate.
